- Collaborate with stakeholders to understand business requirements and translate them into scalable, efficient, and sustainable Dynamics solutions
- Provide technical guidance and mentorship and development for teams to ensure adherence to best practices, standards, and architectural principles
- Conduct thorough analysis of existing systems, processes, and data structures to identify
 opportunities for automation, optimization, and integration with Microsoft Dynamics
 and/or Power Platform.



- Lead the evaluation, selection, and integration of third-party tools and applications to complement and enhance the functionality of Microsoft Dynamics and/or Power Platform solutions
