School Overview:

Overall purpose of the position:

Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

The following gives an indication of the responsibilities of the position. These responsibilities are performed in consultation with the Leadership team.

- Participation in the Spiritual Life of the school and contributing in K-6 Professional Learning teams to use data to drive student learning
- Maintaining consistency and rigour in program development, teaching and learning, reporting and assessment (K-6)
- Overseeing well-being and student behaviour management with your class and other students in the school as appropriate
- Adhering to school compliance and meeting CEDB requirements and effective liaison with parents, parish and community
- Planning and co-leading class information sessions and organisation of school excursions and events and recording student attendance and behaviour through COMPASS and having an understanding of the COMPASS operating system

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be able to demonstrate:

- Commitment to the aims and philosophy of Catholic Education, including a willingness to teach the gospel values and beliefs of the Catholic faith.
- Upholding the equality, dignity and worth of each individual by providing an accepting and affirming classroom environment.
- Possessing appropriate teaching qualifications to be employed as a teacher in a Primary School (Kindergarten to Year 6) and have experience teaching in this setting.
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills. Being able to work collegially as a member of a Professional Learning Team sharing a common vision, talents, ideas, responsibilities and resources.
- Having a sound knowledge and understanding of contemporary classroom practice, including how children learn, classroom management, class programming, assessment, reporting and teaching strategies.
- Knowledge and understanding of the NSW Primary curriculum (NESA).
- Being able to provide excellent teaching/learning experiences in order to encourage self-motivation in students and to ensure sound academic progress.
- Demonstrating confidentiality and being aware of the legal obligations and responsibilities associated with this position.
