### Key Responsibilities

Provides high quality, patient centred care to patients under the supervision of the Head of Emergency Department or Duty Consultant in the Emergency Medicine Department working within their ability and according to the hospitals mission and core values.

Works as part of a multidisciplinary team to review the medical needs of patients within Rockingham Peel Group (RkPG) and provides teaching and support to doctors in training, nursing, allied health and other multidisciplinary team members across the service.

Works with the hospital(s) and health service to achieve National, State, and South Metropolitan Health Service (SMHS) performance standards and targets and National Safety and Quality Healthcare Standards.

## Brief Summary of Duties

### 1. General Duties

- Undertakes clinical shifts and on-call duties as directed by the Head of Emergency Medicine or supervising Consultant(s).
- Treats emergency medicine patients, which includes clinical evaluation, formulating differential diagnosis, arranging appropriate investigations and referrals, and instituting a documented management plan under senior practitioner supervision within own capabilities and experience level.
- Works with hospital nursing staff to facilitate patient management including completing pathology requests, booking radiology and other procedures, checking investigation results and following up abnormal results.
- Communicates and liaises with General Practitioner's (GP's) and specialist(s) as appropriate.
- Assists with the supervision, support, mentoring and teaching of doctors in training, and actively intervenes to reduce delays in patient investigation, management, transfer or discharge.
- Promotes patient engagement in their care, through clear communication with patients/families (at their level of understanding) regarding the patient's condition, options for treatment and progress.
- Participates in unit and Hospital meetings and attends training and lectures.
- Participates in the site Medical Emergency Response Team.

### 2. Education/Training/Research

- Participates in Continuing Professional Development (CPD), evidence based clinical research and audit and educational activities relevant to speciality.
- Participates in the education and training of medical students, doctors in training and other members of the interdisciplinary teams, through ward rounds, formal presentations, tutorials and other modalities.
- Maintains and develops own professional skills and knowledge in accordance with the requirements of the relevant college.
- Completes beginning-of-term planning and end-of-term Professional Development Reviews (PDR's) with the Head of Emergency Medicine or delegate as well as participating in required reviews with supervisors.
- Participates in relevant clinical governance activities including regular clinical meetings, adverse event investigations and morbidity/mortality reviews as required and participates in the implementation of endorsed recommendations.
- Participates in mandatory training activities to ensure compliance with SMHS policies.

### 3. SMHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- Commits to undertake the duties of the role in accordance with the WA Health Code of Conduct, the SMHS Vision and SMHS Values of Care, Integrity, Respect, Excellence and Teamwork.
- Participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- Participates in an annual performance development review.

## Work Related Requirements

The following criteria should be read together with the Brief Summary of Duties and considered in the context of the role and the SMHS Values.

### Essential selection criteria

1. Eligible for registration with the Medical Board of Australia.
2. Registered as a Training Stage 4 Advanced Trainee with the Australasian College of Emergency Medicine (ACEM) or equivalent or holds ACEM Written Fellowship Exam or intends to undertake in the relevant year of application for the role.
3. Completions of critical care requirements as for ACEM training or equivalent.
4. Demonstrated recent clinical and procedural skills, experience and abilities in an equivalent emergency medicine setting.
5. Demonstrated effective communication (verbal and written), interpersonal and conflict resolution skills to effectively interact with patients, families, colleagues and multidisciplinary team members at all levels.
6. Demonstrated organisational and time management skills to provide safe, timely patient centred care.
7. Ability to work effectively as a team member in a multidisciplinary team environment or independently without supervision.
8. Demonstrated experience, commitment and ability to provide education, teaching, supervision, training and support to a variety of personnel.
9. Demonstrated commitment to continuous quality improvement principles.

### Desirable selection criteria

1. Current knowledge and commitment to Equal Opportunity in all aspects of employment and service delivery.

### Appointment Prerequisites

Appointment is subject to:

- Evidence of registration with the Medical Board of Australia prior to commencement.
