

## **Application Selection Criteria**

## Foundation Criteria (minimum standard for all)

- 1. Eligible for general AHPRA registration by the Medical Board of Australia.

  Please note: if you currently have limited / provisional registration but are on the specialist pathway you may still apply. Please ensure all registration documents are attached with your application.
- 2. Must satisfy at least one of the following criteria:
  - Completed or in the process of completing Fellowship of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (FRACGP) or Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (FACRRM).
  - Specialist International Medical Graduates who have received a comparable outcome from either of the colleges mentioned above.
  - Have at least 7 years of recognised clinical experience as a non-vocational general practitioner or rural generalist, practicing independently in specialist clinical areas such as ED, Obstetrics, Anaesthetics, or Surgery.
- 3. A record of appropriate Emergency Department skill maintenance by completing at least 1 of the following in the last 3 years:
  - a. ACLS (or equivalent)
  - b. APLS (or equivalent)
  - c. EMST (or equivalent)
  - d. Rural Emergency Skills Training (or equivalent)
- 4. Demonstrated understanding and knowledge of Aboriginal Cultural respect framework.
- 5. Demonstrated high level commitment to working in a multi-disciplinary team.

## Specialty District Medical Officer Procedural Criteria (for relevant applicants only)

6a. Address if you are applying for District Medical Officer – Procedural Obstetric roles.

- Formal post graduate qualification in Obstetrics, Advanced Diploma of The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists or a recognised equivalent qualification, and extensive and recent experience.
- An annual record of evidence of continued professional development for both:
  - Neonatal Resuscitation (NNR) (or equivalent)
  - Foetal Surveillance Education Program (FSEP) (or equivalent)
- 6b. Address if you are applying for District Medical Officer Procedural Anaesthetic roles.
  - Formal post graduate qualification in anaesthetics, Joint Consultative Committee on Anaesthesia, or Rural Generalist Anaesthetics Training and equivalent extensive experience.
