### RMIT Standings in University Rankings

We are ranked **#1 in the world** for our efforts to reduce inequality in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings 2020.

RMIT has a deep commitment to innovation, research and teaching, we are a 5-Star university under the QS Stars international evaluation system and are **223rd globally in QS World University Rankings 2021** (moved up 15 places compared to 238th last year), being also 18th in the world among universities less than 50 years old (2014 QS Top 50 Under 50 index). Additionally:

- In the 2020 QS World University Rankings by Subject, RMIT was positioned 11th in the world (highest ranked in Australia) in Art and Design, 22nd in the world (fourth highest in Australia) in Architecture and the Built Environment, and 37th in Media and Communications. We are also among the world's top 100 universities in Engineering (Civil and Structural; Electrical and Electronic; and Mechanical, Mechanical, Aeronautical and Manufacturing); Accounting and Finance; and Business and Management Studies).
- In the 2020 QS Rankings by Subject, RMIT was ranked 11th in the world and number one in the Asia Pacific for Art and Design, and 26th in Architecture and the Built Environment. RMIT is also among the world's top 100 universities in Engineering (Civil and Structural; Electrical and Electronic; and Computer Science and Information Systems); Accounting and Finance; Business and Management Studies; and Communication and Media Studies. The 2018 Shanghai Ranking's Global Ranking of Academic Subjects highlighted RMIT's strength in Engineering and Technology in particular.
- In the specialised rankings, RMIT is ranked 77th in the QS Graduate Employability Rankings 2020 and 82nd in the inaugural Times Higher Education University Impact Rankings 2019.
- RMIT has moved up 51 places in the 2021 Times Higher Education World University Rankings, strengthening its reputation as a leading global university. The University has leapt more than 150 places since 2015 and is now ranked in the **top 301-350 band**.
- RMIT continued its strong performance in the 2020 CWTS Leiden Ranking, which ranks the world's top research-intensive universities, moving up 21 places to be ranked **293rd globally** on proportion of international publications, and **ranking 225th** on proportion of top 5% publications, up 120 places from 2019.

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### Position Summary

The Contracts Manager is responsible for developing appropriate agreements for industry engagement and partnerships activities and for providing commercial advice and recommendations, for negotiating and facilitating the drafting of complex contracts and providing oversight of those contracts pre-execution.

The role is responsible for an end to end management of contracts lifecycle from drafting to execution of contracts.

This role will work closely with the Senior Manager, Partnerships and Industry Engagement to maintain an awareness of development activities and possible work arising and to ensure the timely and accurate development and execution of contracts to optimise service delivery expectations.

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### Organisational Accountabilities

RMIT University is committed to the health, safety and wellbeing of its staff. 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### Key Accountabilities

- Ensure the execution of acceptable contracts within set timeframes.
- Provide expert commercial advice to key stakeholders on contract processes and commercial terms, including compliance obligations and risk mitigation to maximise partnerships with industry and government while balancing risk to RMIT by drawing on substantial commercial acumen, an understanding of the university sector, a close understanding of School and College business development strategies, and a sound understanding of the matters at hand.
- Scope, negotiate and arrange execution of acceptable contracts within set legal, financial, commercial and resourcing timeframes to provide for a wide range of research and learning and teaching activities.
- Undertake due diligence activities on potential contracting parties to inform strategic decision making in business development and contract management.
- Provide high-level oversight, guidance and coordination in the management of all contracts including:

- Ensuring that all subsidiary contracts and supporting documents are in place as required by an executed agreement;
  - Assisting in resolving compliance exceptions;
  - Facilitating the resolution of post-execution issues resulting in 'distressed' or defaulted contracts.
- Contribute to the development of, and work according to, agreed processes for the development and management of contracts including workflow processes and decision matrices, delegations, workflow spread sheets and document management systems.
  - Build and maintain strong relationships with RMIT Legal Services and Finance Group staff to gather information, seek and act on advice, negotiate acceptable contracts and resolve commercial and management issues.
  - Ensure that contracts with external partners are on standard templates approved by the Central RMIT Legal team and, where the standard terms are varied, provide advice on the nature of these variations such that these contracts can be locally resolved and signed. Where there are significant variations in contracts with external parties, provide a brief to the Central RMIT Legal team and liaise with them to ensure smooth interactions with the external parties.
  - Ensure that the queue of open matters is always minimal. Triage matters effectively and either handle them locally or pass them centrally with appropriate briefs.
  - Effectively engage with a multitude of stakeholders both internal and external to Provide contract-related issue resolution
  - Monitor and complete contract close-out, extension or renewal, as appropriate.
  - Assist other teams across the portfolio and College as required within the scope of this classification.
  - Be accountable for your own actions and workload to positively influence the team culture and consistently demonstrate RMIT's values.

### **Key Selection Criteria**

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1. Proven skills and experience in contracts management with a strong commitment to stakeholder engagement.
2. Substantial commercial acumen and demonstrated experience negotiating a wide range of contracts with a variety of different industries and developing and managing research contracts with national and international funding bodies.
3. Demonstrated experience in providing whole-of-life management of contracts to ensure obligations are met.
4. Demonstrated ability to develop initiatives and solutions informed by comprehensive quantitative and qualitative data analysis.
5. Proven administrative skills with the ability to handle confidential issues responsibly.
6. Demonstrated ability to simultaneously manage complex tasks with a commitment to meeting strict deadlines.
7. High level computer skills with experience using Microsoft Office software, databases and project management software.
8. High level communication, influencing and negotiating skills, with the ability to build productive relationships within the organisation and externally.
9. Demonstrated understanding and experience of the key principles of intellectual property management including identification, due diligence, protection and commercialisation, with intellectual property transactional experience in science and/or engineering disciplines highly regarded.
