Guide for Candidates – Security Background Check Requirements

A security background check must be completed before your commencement date. To facilitate this, identification documents and an electronic photograph must be provided to Security as soon as possible.

1. Identification Documents

You must present your original identification documents to an Airservices Authorised Issuing Body Representative (IB Representative).

Once you have satisfied the identity requirements, the IB Representative will take a copy of your identification documents and certify it as a true copy. This copy must then be used to accompany your application.

Each Airservices staffed location has an IB Representative.

For a list of acceptable identification documents – See Attached: Acceptable Identification Documents – ASIC Applications

Additional requirements (if applicable):

- All foreign language documents must be **accompanied** by an English translation, conducted by an accredited or professional translator.
- All identification documents provided must contain exact name matches, unless the name variation is supported by a valid linking document, such as an official marriage certificate, change of name certificate or deed poll.

A statutory declaration is not an acceptable change of name linkage document.

Once your documents have been copied and certified by an IB Representative, they can be scanned and emailed, or mailed to Security at:

An identification document will only be accepted once it has been certified as a true copy by an IB Representative.

2. Electronic Photograph

A passport quality electronic photograph must be provided.

The image file must be sent as an attachment in **JPG** format and must follow the naming conventionsurname_firstname_middleinitial_sap number

If you do not know your SAP number, leave this blank

The JPG photograph **MUST**:

- be taken on a plain matt-white background,
- have appropriate brightness and contrast with uniform lighting,
- be in focus and clear,
- show your full face, head and shoulders square, looking straight at the camera,
- show your eyes open and clearly visible (no flash reflection from glasses, frames should not cover any part of your eyes).

The JPG photograph must **NOT**:

- be a passport-sized photo or closely cropped (passport images are generally too small),
- show any shadows, 'red eye' or uneven lighting,
- be older than 6 months, or
- be a scanned copy.

Your photograph will be rejected if it does not meet compliance as stated above.
