Purpose

- Produce concise, accurate and engaging copy / edits that have been tailored for a breakfast television audience. Check stories and content for factual and style errors / inconsistencies.
- Develop and maintain a sound understanding of current events and issues, monitoring a wide range of media outlets / sources to develop a strong understanding of current events, issues and popular culture.
- Contribute to the editorial discussion by suggesting discussion points and guest ideas as well as ideas for how to freshen and update developing stories.
- Assist with other duties associated with News Breakfast including social media activity, screen producing, planning producing and online video processing.
- Generate stories that are relevant to a broad section of Australians and reflect the cultural, geographic and socio-economic diversity of the country.

- Actively engage with communities in Australia's outer suburbs to find and tell stories that are relevant for them and in line with the Audience First News Strategy.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
