Purpose

Contribute to a new, weekly TV current affairs program focused on the Pacific. Provide editorial input as part of the program team, helping to curate, report, output and present, working closely with the APN Pacific team.

- Write and produce bespoke content with a digital-first approach, with a particular focus on the Pacific.
- Attend and proactively contribute ideas at team and wider newsroom editorial meetings. Collaborate with other newsroom teams on editorial content and treatment of content.
- Communicate effectively with colleagues and other senior editorial staff in the newsroom and wider ABC.

- Work in various roles across the program as required, including reporting, presenting and producing.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
- Cooperate with any reasonable instruction, procedure or policy relating to safety and take reasonable care for your own safety and that of other people who may be affected by your conduct while at work.
