



SA Medical Imaging Radiographer / Sonographer / Nuclear Medicine Technologist Candidate Pool - Applicant Fact Sheet

The SA Medical Imaging (SAMI) Radiographer / Sonographer Candidate Pool is now open to registered Radiographers and Sonographers interested in joining SAMI for casual or short term employment opportunities. Below are some frequently asked questions for applicants.

Welcome to SA Medical Imaging

SA Medical Imaging is a Statewide Service that provides specialist, integrated, multi-discipline and medical imaging services to public and private inpatients, outpatients and emergency department patients within six (6) metropolitan and four (4) country South Australian hospitals.

SAMI is the largest public imaging provider in Australia and employs staff across a variety of disciplines including specialist radiologists, medical physicists, radiographers, sonographers, nursing and administrative support staff. SAMI specialist services include:

- Angiography
- Fluoroscopy
- Mammography
- MRI scanning
- Paediatric imaging
- Interventional imaging
- CT scanning
- General x-ray
- Radiation Safety
- Nuclear medicine
- Ultrasound
- Women's Imaging

What types of roles are available through the Radiographer / Sonographer Candidate Pool?

Casual and temporary roles will be offered through the candidate pool for vacancies of a minimum of 4 weeks up to 12 months. These roles can be offered by any SA Medical Imaging site.

As part of the post interview process, you will be required to provide the following information:

- Preference site or LHN that you would be able to work at
- Days of the week that you are available

Where are potential positions located?

NB – Candidates working at some SA Medical Imaging Country sites (i.e. Clare Hospital, Pt Pirie Hospital and Riverland General Hospital (Berri)) may be eligible to receive a travel and accommodation allowance.

How do I apply to the SA Medical Imaging Radiographer / Sonographer Candidate Pool?

Applicants are also welcome to apply for specific vacancies within SAMI at any time using the online application system. Current vacancies can be found at <http://www.sahealthcareers.com.au/> or via <http://iworkforsa.gov.au/>.

Should the panel wish to consider your application for the candidate pool, you will be advised through your nominated email address.

What will I need when applying?

To assist you in applying for the candidate pool, the following documentation will be required:

- A current resume / curriculum vitae
- Evidence of your professional registration
- Contact details (email and telephone) of two (2) current referees, including current / previous line manager
- Visa / passport details (if you are not a permanent Australian resident)
- You may be required to complete a pre-interview questionnaire and submit your continuing professional development plan if you are invited for further assessment.

What are the eligibility requirements?

Registration or eligible for registration as a radiographer / sonographer with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (APHRA).

Hold a current license under the Radiation Protection and Control Act 1982.

Meet all Credentialling requirements including current Criminal and Relevant History Employment Screening (DHS WWCC/Child Related Employment screening and National Police Check Vulnerable/DHS Vulnerable Person Related Screening)

What are the terms and conditions of my employment with SAMI?

Radiographer positions within the Candidate Pool will be offered at the AHP1 / AHP2 classification and Sonographer positions will be offered at the AHP2 / AHP3 classification in accordance with the SA Modern Public Sector Enterprise Agreement: Salaried 2017.

How do you select your applicants?

The shortlisting process may comprise a combination of selection processes including assessment of written applications and interviews. The panel will shortlist suitable applicants and may invite them to attend an interview

The panel will conduct reference checks for all applicants who are invited to attend an interview. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the listed referee's details are current.

How will I receive further information / communication from SA Medical Imaging?

SAMI will liaise with applicants via email correspondence. Please ensure your email is monitored for possible correspondence from SAMI.

If I am successful in the recruitment process, what happens next?

SAMI are responsible for maintaining a Candidate Pool register which will provide managers with the following details:

- Contact details
- Criminal History Checks
- Availability
- Preferred SAMI site
- Orientation
- Application

The Radiographer / Sonographer Candidate Pool Register will be shared with SA Medical Imaging staff who undertake the responsibility for recruitment at each SA Medical Imaging site or Local Health Network. You will be contacted directly by phone when a position becomes available.

How long will SA Medical Imaging hold my application?

If you have applied for the Candidate Pool and have not been contacted within 12 months, your application will not be considered further. The candidate pool is advertised every 12 months and for those applicants that were not considered, they must reapply.

Should you no longer wish to be considered for the Candidate Pool, please consider withdrawing your application. Successful applicants that have been engaged in SAMI contracts in the preceding 12 months will be automatically transitioned to the following years pool.

Successful applicants who have not engaged in SAMI contracts in the preceding 12 months will be required to reapply for the following year's candidate pool campaign and undergo the application process.

What do I do if I change my address or email details?

If you change your personal details at any time following the submission of your application you are required to visit the SA Health website www.health.sa.gov.au/careers and log in using your profile, select Edit Profile, click on Personal Details, update your details and then save. This is a live system so you can go in and update personal details at any time.

If your contact details change after being accepted into the SAMI Radiographer / Sonographer Candidate Pool, you are required to provide your updated details via SAMI Corporate Office via Health.DocumentationSAMedicalImaging@sa.gov.au
