Applicant FAQ's

The Theatre Orderly Candidate Pool campaign has been designed to allow applicants to register their interest in work at the Southern Adelaide Local Health Network (SALHN).

Below are some of the applicant's frequently asked questions.

How do I apply to the SALHN Theatre Orderly Pool?

To lodge an application, complete an online application form, which can be found at www.iworkfor.sa.gov.au or www.sahealth.sa.gov.au/careers

What will I need when applying?

- A current resume/curriculum vitae to assist in populating the application
- A cover letter addressing essential requirements
- Contact details of three referees (email and telephone)
- Visa/passport details (if you are not a permanent Australian resident)

A National Police clearance is not a mandatory requirement at the time of application

When will my application be reviewed?

Applications are received on a continuing basis throughout 2025. Your application will remain on file up to 28 February 2026 for consideration and you may be contacted at any time to undertake a pre-screening questionnaire to determine suitability for the role.

If you are shortlisted, you will be invited to an in person formal interview to further discuss your application.

Invitations are sent electronically using the interview automated booking feature in e-recruitment.

If you no longer wish to be considered for this candidate pool, please withdraw your application online.

What happens after my interview?

You will be contacted to advise the outcome of your interview.

If you are successful, we will then begin reference checks and collecting compliance documentation ready for onboarding.

This role will require you to provide a National Police Clearance that has been obtained within the last 12 months. We encourage that you do not obtain a police clearance until after you have been offered a position to avoid unnecessary expenses.

Applicant FAQ's

Do I need to undergo any pre-employment medical checks?

The immunisation category for this role is Category A. You will undergo an Immunisation Compliance Assessment in line with the SA Health's addressing vaccine preventable disease: Occupational assessment, screening, and vaccination policy.

It is necessary for all staff working at Noarlunga Hospital to undertake a hearing assessment.

If successful in gaining employment with the SALHN Hotel Services Theatre Orderly pool, what will be my conditions of employment?

You will be employed and paid in accordance with the South Australian Public Sector Wages Parity Enterprise Agreement: Weekly Paid 2022

What to expect from the role?

The Theatre Orderly performs a full range of duties both inside and outside of the Operating Theatre, including patient transport, positioning of patients, set-up of theatre equipment and any associated cleaning and ancillary duties. Orderlies are required to work over a 24/7 roster to support the multi-disciplinary team.

Does SALHN support applicants who hold an eligible VISA?

Yes, however in accordance with the Immigration Department requirements priority will always be given to applicants who are either Australian Citizens or Australian Residents in the first instance. Visa holders continue to have a right to apply, however the right to placement is secondary to local applicants (Australian Citizens or Residents).
