Be the point of contact and liaison with the customer or their representatives during the course of a project.
4. Propose, develop and implement business improvement, technology development and innovation to generate Queensland Rail's commercial advantage.
5. Take a central role in a team of engineering professionals, including multi-disciplinary project-based teams to ensure delivery of effective and commercially valuable civil engineering solutions.
6. Monitor the implementation of projects, maintain programs and budgets and co-ordinate reviews for forecasting and corrective action. Co-ordinate change management process for scope pricing, program and all other relevant aspects of the project. Complete or
