Position Purpose

- Lead the development and implementation of key policy and programs relating to plumbing assessment and compliance services to improve efficiency, quality and service delivery.
- Support the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focussed culture.
- Build strong relationships with key internal and external stakeholders to ensure quality services outcomes are achieved.
- Represent Council as required providing expert knowledge and advice to key stakeholders.
