Position Purpose

This position will provide technical leadership and direction to a team providing specialist traffic engineering advice and management of the planning and design of a series of traffic and transport sub programs to meet the needs of the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As a leader within the transport network management team you will:

- Provide technical leadership to a small team of technical officers responsible for the planning and design of traffic and transport projects and manage the submission process for entering these projects into the capital and operational works programs.
- Lead the delivery of complex traffic and transport sub programs including the identification of new, upgrades and renewals projects for populating traffic and transport sub programs.
- Lead the preparation of concept designs and cost estimates to accurately forecast financial budgets.
- Prepare and present complex technical reports for consideration by management and other key stakeholders as required.
- Provide technical input into annual capital and operational works programs and ensure these programs are reviewed, updated on a regular basis and remain current.
- Undertake regular meetings with council's elected members to provide detailed updates and undertake other meetings with customers as required. Some of these meetings may be outside of council's normal working hours.
- Develop team capability and drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focussed team culture.
- Build high level relationships with internal and external stakeholders to optimise service outcomes including one network transport solutions with the various Queensland State Government departments to promote modal change in a rapidly growing metropolitan region.
