- Act as a point of contact for operational maintenance matters by providing sound advice, innovation and problem solving, with a technical focus on road and civil issues.
- Undertake engineering design, review, procurement process, project management and delivery of road infrastructure renewal projects, fulfilling a project and construction management and programming role for works as directed.
- Undertake project management tasks relevant to the delivery of council's Capital and Operational infrastructure programs, projects and services.
- Provide technical support consulting with a range of internal and external stakeholders, with a focus on whole of life asset costs.
- Act independently and as an effective team member, in the management of contract works to ensure projects are completed in accordance with requirements and scheduled delivery timeframes.
- Monitor and report on project and program delivery phases, across/including financial, quality, timing and safety requirements.
