Position Purpose

This position will provide planning expertise and lead the delivery of highly complex natural hazards, environmental, climate change and resilience planning projects and services to meet the needs of the organisation and the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As a Principal Planner within the Environmental and Sustainability Policy and Planning team you will:

- Act as a technical expert and provide leadership and direction to team members in the delivery of integrated natural hazards and climate change adaptation outcomes across the region and within the MBRC organisation.
- Provide expert advice in environmental and natural hazards planning matters in accordance with legislative, policy and business requirements.
- Lead the delivery of highly complex environmental and natural hazards planning projects and specialist project teams (including external consultants) to achieve strategic and business outcomes.
- Take a leadership role in the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Provide specialist technical expertise into the development, integration and implementation of key strategies and policy relating to natural hazards, climate change, resilience and other significant major planning initiatives.
- Facilitate project-based community consultation including representing Council at a range of customer meetings, community and business forums.
- Build high level relationships across a range of diverse internal and external stakeholders to ensure projects and service deliverables are achieved.
- Act as a department delegate and advocate on a variety of projects, providing a source of professional advice to key stakeholders.

- Excellent communication skills with an ability to communicate complex environmental planning concepts and matters in a simple and concise manner (both verbally and in written form) and negotiate safe, practicable and sustainable outcomes.
- Substantial experience in stakeholder consultation and engagement associated with the delivery of highly complex environmental and natural hazards projects.
