Position Purpose

This position provides specialist infrastructure planning expertise to contribute to the development and delivery of strategic planning and policy activities for Council's transport infrastructure networks to meet the needs of the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As a principal strategic infrastructure planner and member of the Strategic Infrastructure Planning team you will:

- Lead the development and delivery of long-term, regional infrastructure planning, strategies and policy having regard to relevant statutory, policy and financial provisions and Council direction to drive integrated and sustainable planning outcomes;
- Undertake complex transport infrastructure network planning, master planning, costing and prioritisation for key planning projects including the Local Government Infrastructure Plan (LGIP) amendment and Growth Areas Management program and the provision of strategic advice in accordance with legislative, policy and business requirements.
- Undertake the development and delivery of transport infrastructure strategies and policy to support the development of major developments and high growth areas and to meet business needs and community expectations.
- Provide technical input into the development and maintenance of strategic transport, financial and geospatial models, annual capital and operational works programs.
- Provide coordination between and clear direction to Council stakeholders to support the effective delivery of long-term infrastructure policy and planning.
- Support the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focussed culture.
- Build high level relationships across a range of diverse internal and external stakeholders and engage with relevant State agencies to ensure quality infrastructure network service outcomes are achieved.
