This position will provide specialist transport planning advice on complex transport issues for significant projects; including the preparation, leadership and review of integrated transport plans, concept plans and cost estimates.

As a Principal Planner within the Integrated Transport Planning team you will:

- Lead the planning, analysis, coordination and development of complex integrated transport plans and concept planning that will address significant challenges within the MBRC transport network and result in recommendations that align with council's strategic principles and policies.
- Manage consultants to investigate and identify infrastructure strategies and solutions for the future delivery of trunk transport infrastructure within the region.
- Operate within a multi-disciplinary team and mentor junior staff for the planning and design of innovative solutions that integrate transport, water sensitive design, street scaping and urban design outcomes.
- Develop and provide planning and recommendations for high quality multimodal transport solutions considering amenity, connectivity, efficiency and safety of users.
- Undertake analytical processes to identify preferred integrated transport solutions considering all road user needs.
- Provide technical input into a variety of annual capital and operational works programs and assist in their review and update.
- Manage projects utilising contemporary best practices including initiating, planning, executing, monitoring and closing to deliver on time and on budget project results.
- Contribute high level transport planning knowledge and specialist advice, assisting in establishing and communicating contemporary best practice transport planning and design guidelines.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Engage proactively with key stakeholders to ensure quality service outcomes are achieved and constructively deal with any customer services enquiries or complaints referred for action.
