Purpose of Role

Carry out work based training to develop skills in undertaking arboriculture activities within council's public open space network in a safe and efficient manner.

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Specific Responsibilities
Assist with onsite arboricultural services, activities and project delivery.
Assist with the assessment of trees in regard to health, risk and proposed maintenance.
Work at heights to carry out arboricultural work.
Through work based training, develop a diverse range of trade and technical knowledge.
Correctly use and maintain plant and equipment provided, including all personal protective equipment, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, council's safety policy and procedures.
Ensure compliance with all legislation, approved standards, policies and procedures relating to the team's practices and processes.
Maintain good working relations and deal cooperatively with members of the public and team members.
Work Experiences and Skills - essential
Ability to undertake a number of arboriculture activities with minimal supervision.
Ability to work in a team environment, communicate effectively and contribute to a positive work environment with a focus on providing quality customer service.
Ability to determine safe working practices relating to physical tasks.
Willingness to work in a variety of work locations including working at heights.
Ability to learn new tasks and acquire new skills.
Trade Qualifications and Other Licences - essential
Current C class driver's licence.
Aptitude and ability to enrol and complete a Certificate III in Arboriculture (EWP).
Construction Induction Card competency that has been used or obtained within the past 2 years.
