### Position Purpose

As the Senior Stormwater Planner within the Drainage, Waterways and Coastal Planning team you will:

- Act as a technical expert provide leadership and guidance to team members in the delivery of stormwater infrastructure planning and policy matters to drive integrated and sustainable planning outcomes.
- Provide expert advice in infrastructure planning and policy matters in accordance with legislative, policy and business requirements.
- Investigate complex stormwater planning problems and prepare and present technical reports and recommendations to ensure project outcomes are met.
- Coordinate and/or undertake planning studies to support infrastructure projects delivered by DWCP (including management of specialist consultants).
- Support project-based community consultation including representing Council at a range of customer meetings, community and business forums.
- Support the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focussed culture.
- Building strong relationships and engage with internal and external stakeholders to ensure stormwater and waterway infrastructure and service delivery outcomes are achieved.
