Purpose of Role

To manage planning phase activities for capital works infrastructure projects, including the provision of professional building and/or engineering support within the department.

Specific Responsibilities

Act as a point of contact for capital works project development phase matters by providing expert advice, innovation and problem solving through the exercise of judgement.

Manage the planning phase delivery of infrastructure projects, fulfilling a project management role for works as directed.

Coordinate the planning phase concept design for projects, including liaison with internal and external providers, consultants, contractors and project stakeholders.

Where required, undertake project management tasks relevant to the delivery of key Council infrastructure and services including the review of project scopes, design review, cost estimation, constructability considerations, contract documentation, specifications, quality and environmental issues.

Work independently, and interdependently with project managers where directed, in the management of pre-construction works, to ensure projects are effectively planned to streamline production of: design drawings, technical specifications, contract management requirements, stakeholder liaison, quality control, including the inspection and supervision of construction works to ensure that projects are completed in compliance with all requirements.

Where required, undertake or seek consultancy for assessment, inspections, and investigations throughout the planning period including: building condition audits, engineering studies, feasibility studies, planning assessment and concept design.

Report on project development and planning phase issues including project development phase progress, financial expenditure and forward budgets, consultancy contractual issues, risks and communications requirements.

Work Experiences and Skills – essential

Demonstrated relevant experience in a similar role or a role requiring a similar skill set.

Demonstrated ability to understand project documents, design drawings, specifications, schedules and contracts having regard for relevant construction standards and Australian Standards.

Demonstrated ability to apply critical thinking, reasoning, evaluation and decision-making skills.

Excellent time management skills to achieve proficiency and effectiveness in managing conflicting priorities and meeting deadlines.

Highly-developed people and relationship skills with demonstrated ability to work in a team environment communicating and motivating effectively at all levels of the organisation, contributing to a positive work environment with a strong focus on provision of quality customer service.

Academic, Trade Qualifications and other Licences - essential

Degree in architecture, engineering, construction management or other relevant field.

Current C class driver's licence.

Construction Induction Card competency that has been used or obtained within the past 2 years.

Recordkeeping
