Position Purpose

To carry out water truck operations in a competent, safe and efficient way to achieve required outcomes for the Moreton Bay Regional Council and its community.

Responsibilities & Outcomes

- Provide water truck services and carry out site watering to a number of different civil construction and maintenance activities.
- Provide water truck services to council ensure areas mapped for landscape maintenance watering are serviced in accordance with specified timeframes and standards, including but not limited to hand watering, establishment watering and liquid fertilizer applications (Parks).
- Operate relevant plant and equipment associated with the position in an appropriate manner and ensure assets are properly secured when not in use.
- Build good working relationships across the broader Asset Maintenance department to ensure quality working relations with internal stakeholders, team members and the public.
- Undertake daily checks, basic maintenance, servicing and cleaning of the vehicle/plant each day and report all defects in accordance with council requirements.
- Assist Fleet Services in rectifying relevant maintenance of relevant plant.
- Correctly use and maintain plant and equipment provided, including all personal protective equipment, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, council's safety policy and procedures.
