- Develop, implement and maintain effective asset management practices and improvements including data collection, asset condition analysis, asset lifecycle analysis, engineering design standards, levels of service, effective intervention treatments and the asset handover process.
- Prepare and update Council's asset management plans and identify and complete associated action items in order to achieve asset management best practice.
- Prepare and update technical specifications for the accurate and timely capture of condition and defect data (including project management of contractors) across all Council asset classes.
- Provide specialist asset management advice to key stakeholders to ensure Council assets are managed in an integrated and effective manner across Council to minimise risk and optimise asset utilisation, asset life and whole of life costs.
- Identify and develop asset management practices and improvements that integrates appropriate asset management processes into all Council operations including system, business process and technological improvements.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Build strong relationships with key stakeholders to ensure asset management service outcomes with an emphasis on promoting and facilitating change in a rapidly growing metropolitan region.
