Position Purpose

This position will provide transport planning advice for the development of integrated transport planning projects to meet the needs of the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

As a senior planner within the Integrated Transport Planning team you will:

- Provide technical advice and detailed analysis for complex transport planning area, corridor, link and intersection upgrade studies to inform the development and improvement of Council's capital works program and transport planning operational program.
- Draft, develop, lead and manage transport planning scopes/projects and consultancy briefs/engagements
- Prepare, author or otherwise review comprehensive and qualified reports related to traffic and transport planning or engineering matters
- Work collaboratively with internal and external stakeholders with diverse skillsets including but not limited to traffic engineering, transport data analytics and modelling, design and strategic planning
- Ensure that projects/planning align and consistent with Council's strategic direction and objectives and accurately inform future stages within the project or planning lifecycle
- Respond to Councillor and Customer requests as required and employ a range of verbal, visual and written communication techniques including where necessary community consultation and engagement with internal and external stakeholders
- Build relationships across a range of diverse internal and external stakeholders and engage with relevant State agencies to ensure quality infrastructure network service outcomes are achieved and outcomes respond to Council's strategic directions.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and learning, and customer focused culture.
