Position Purpose

This position will support the Project Development Manager to effectively undertake commercial, quality and administrative activities associated with a range of capital projects. Working in partnership this position will ensure the financial position of the construction program is accurately reported and controlled effectively.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

- Undertake a range of construction estimating, costing and quantity surveying services on forward capital projects.
- Undertake cost assessment of completed estimates to inform risks and opportunities across the project life-cycle and construction planning in a project and portfolio management environment.
- Act as a point of contact for a range of stakeholders on quantity surveying matters, including program level budget and specialist advice across the project management department.
- Prepare and maintain forecast reporting for cost management associated with planning, design, procurement and construction phases of programmed works.
- Undertake the preparation of feasibility estimates to inform the forward capital works program.
- Provide a range of risk guidance and support in post tender evaluations and assist in procurement, including input into supply and matters associated with subcontract agreements.
- Deliver work in compliance with all legislation, approved standards, policies and procedures relating to project management practices and processes.
- Work with a range of internal and external stakeholders ensuring optimal service delivery standards are met.
