### Position Purpose

This position will provide senior planning expertise and lead and support the delivery of moderate-to-complex strategic infrastructure planning projects and services to meet the needs of the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

### Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

#### Operational

As a Senior Infrastructure Planner within the Strategic Infrastructure Planning department you will:

- Act as a technical expert provide leadership and guidance to team members in the delivery of strategic infrastructure planning and policy matters to drive integrated and sustainable planning outcomes.
- Provide expert advice in strategic infrastructure planning and policy matters in accordance with legislative, policy and business requirements.
- Assist in the delivery of moderate-to-complex infrastructure planning projects and project teams (including external consultants) to achieve strategic and business outcomes.
- Support the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focussed culture.
- Provide senior technical input into the development and implementation of key infrastructure policy matters relating to the planning scheme including amending the Local Government Infrastructure Plan.
- Support project-based community consultation including representing Council at a range of customer meetings, community and business forums.
- Build high level relationships across a range of diverse internal and external stakeholders to ensure projects and service deliverables are achieved.
- Act as a department delegate on a variety of projects, providing a source of professional advice to key stakeholders.
