Position Purpose

This position will provide specialist engineering advice and manage a complex portfolio of multi-facet asset class projects (i.e. Bridges, Sporting facilities) which meets the needs of Council's residents and ratepayers.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

As a Project Manager and member of the Project Development and Delivery Department you will:

- Manage a complex portfolio of multi-facet asset class projects including administration, supervision and management of contracts through stages of procurement, award, construction, defects liability and maintenance periods.
- Manage the approvals process and ability to secure approvals with minimal guidance.
- Undertake complex planning and investigation of projects including the investigation of alternate solutions, cost estimation and constructability considerations; and generate technical reports for consideration by management.
- Provide specialist engineering advice and ensure engineering works are undertaken in accordance with current construction legislation, Australian standards, Workplace Health and Safety requirements and accepted work practices.
- Manage the infrastructure design process including coordination and management of consultants to ensure projects are run to schedule.
- Resolve complex construction issues associated with multi-facet asset projects.
- Assess, recommend and reject progressive payment certificate claims made by contractors up to the accumulated value of the project.
- Ensure engineering works are undertaken safely and in accordance with relevant legislation and workplace health and safety requirements.
- Provide technical oversight, direction and guidance to the engineering team in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused team culture.
- Build strong relationships with internal and external stakeholders to ensure project deliverables and outcomes are achieved
