Develop and deliver educational units and experiences that meet student needs and align with curriculum requirements.

Maintain and broaden your knowledge of contemporary teaching practices in your discipline and/or clinical dentistry.

Create educational resources that reflect current and innovative practices in the field.

Supervise students during their clinical practice.

Assist with administrative duties within the DMD course and/or Unit of Study.

Coordinate discipline-specific and clinical placement opportunities, working with universities, community stakeholders, and health organizations.

Contribute to the design and implementation of assessments and demonstrate student learning outcomes at the Unit and Course levels.

Supervise students during their rural and remote placements as needed.

Participate in team activities such as meetings, strategic planning, and program development.

Carry out additional duties as assigned by the Head of School and the Discipline Chair.
