Some teaching/workshop experience in bioinformatics in a variety of face-to-face and/or hybrid and online modes to actively engage and educate undergraduate and post graduate students to ensure student success across the disciplines of genetics, biochemistry, molecular biology or microbiology. 5. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with excellent time management and an ability to work collaboratively as a member of an academic team. 6. Exemplary personal qualities fully aligned with our institutional values of integrity, respect, collegiality, excellence and discovery.
