- 5. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with excellent time management and an ability to work collaboratively as a member of an academic team.
- 6. Exemplary personal qualities fully aligned with our institutional values of integrity, respect, collegiality, excellence and discovery.

DESIRED CHARACTERISTICS
