As the Trainee Operator Supply, you will develop competencies to be able to assist in carrying out activities associated with the operation of Water Treatment Plants and other water related infrastructure to effectively meet requirements relating to water delivery, regulatory standards, and operational efficiencies.

This position may require the successful applicant to participate in an on-call roster and to respond to call-outs at any time outside of normal working hours, once reaching a suitable level of competence.

Appointment to this role is subject to the provision of a national police check. Please note that people with criminal records are not automatically deemed ineligible. Each application will be considered on its merits.

Key responsibilities

The Trainee Operator Supply always works under supervision to undertake the following:

- Collect and assist with the analysis process of sampling in accordance with schedule and protocol.
- Assist the Operator to establish chemical doses and process variables using the SCADA system.
- Assist in carrying out laboratory testing to ascertain proper operation of the process.
- Assist the Water Treatment Plant Operators as required.
- Assist the Operator to evaluate problems with treatment processes and equipment that will impact on plant output and water quality and implement remedial actions.
- Assist in the delivery of water quality and environmental catchment sampling programs through the collation and analysis of water samples.
- Assist with identifying equipment faults, and implement changes or contingency
 plans as directed, to maintain satisfactory plant operation and aiding Operators
 to initiate corrective actions using the Work Request system.
- Assist in compiling and recording plant operational data daily. Report all breakdowns, spillage, and abnormal occurrences to ensure problems are resolved promptly and information is accurately recorded.
- Assist preparation and maintenance of water treatment infrastructure and plant equipment and undertake general maintenance as required.
- Assist internal and external service providers in their delivery of routine preventative, planned and breakdown maintenance as required.
- Assist with tours of Water Treatment plants and communicate messages via PC, pager system, two-way radio, telephone and office PC in a prompt, courteous and accurate manner.
- Assist the logging of shift events and when requested, prepare written reports for presentations.
- Assist internal and external service providers in their delivery of routine preventative, planned and breakdown maintenance as required.



- Gain familiarity with the operation of the management systems and gain knowledge of word processor and spreadsheet programs.
- Model Seqwater's values on a day-to-day basis; Respect, Care, Integrity, and Courage.
- Meet the ongoing learning requirements of the training program, completing required modules within a reasonable timeframe.
- Actively participate in operational activities that contribute to overall learning experiences.
