Position Summary

UNSW Medicine & Health is undertaking an ambitious project (the Medicine Program Redesign – MPR) to align its flagship undergraduate Medicine program with the future needs of the health workforce. The Senior Manager Education Design & Development plays a key role within this project, working closely with the Associate Dean Innovation, driving high quality content and digital education design and development, and providing strategic advice in fostering innovation and enhancing staff and student experience.

The role has end to end responsibility for managing the creation, sourcing, design and development of content and collateral for educational resources for the MPR project. It entails managing the design and development of quality learning activities, online modules, courses, and programs in collaboration with MPR team members and academic staff to achieve learning and teaching strategies for the redesigned Medicine Program. The application of pedagogical theories, frameworks, and best practices to inform innovative educational design is an essential element of this role. The role has up to 4 direct reports.

Accountabilities

Specific accountabilities for this role include:

- Work collaboratively with MPR team members and faculty staff to manage the design and development of innovative learning activities and resources for the UNSW Medicine Program Redesign project, to improve staff and students' experience.
- Strong technological literacy across a range of education products and platforms with demonstrated experience in the design of learner-centred programs and effective use of learning and teaching strategies.
- Manage effective communications and develop strong influential relationships with key stakeholders through consultation, provision of advice and change management to develop and implement innovative teaching strategies.
- Drive, in collaboration with academic leads of the MPR project, various stages of strategic educational investigations including research on latest pedagogical innovations, to ensure that emerging and existing educational design and technologies are incorporated into the work of the MPR project.
- Take a systematic and evidence-based approach to course design and development, reviewing, and implementing appropriate revisions to the Medicine program.
- Develop and deploy visual dashboards and simulation technologies to create stimulating active learning environments and communities of practice for staff and students.
- Manage the design and development of quality blended learning activities, modules, programs, and courses in collaboration with academic staff, using best practice learning and teaching strategies to improve learning outcomes.
- For the MPR project, interpret requirements of academic leads and provide proactive advice and solution-focused action in relation to learning programs, technology, and platforms to design the framework for technology enhanced learning in the program and support its implementation.in a timely and accurate manner.
- Collaborate with academic leads to apply pedagogical teaching and learning strategies to guide curriculum.
- Develop, coordinate, and evaluate professional development initiatives, workshops and seminars for academic staff related to curriculum design and the integration of technology in the program.
- Align with and actively demonstrate the <u>UNSW Values in Action: Our Behaviours</u> and the <u>UNSW</u>
 Code of Conduct.
- Ensure hazards and risks psychosocial and physical are identified and controlled for tasks, projects, and activities that pose a health and safety risk within your area of responsibility.
