 supervision, marking assessments, and other coordination duties.
- Depending on intertest and capacity, undertake lecturing and engage in mathematical research or scholarship.
- Assist in course assessment, administration and curriculum development and outreach activities.
- Undertake administrative duties as specified by the Head of School and/or the Director, First Year Studies
- Align with and actively demonstrate the <u>UNSW Values in Action: Our Behaviours</u> and the <u>UNSW Code of Conduct</u>.
