Essential qualifications and experience:

- Certificate IV in Allied Health Assistance or equivalent
- Current First Aid Certificate

Essential competencies:

- Demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of BaptistCare's Christian identity and promote the organisation's values through interactions at work.
- Demonstrated experience working with older people in a community setting.
- Demonstrated ability to prioritise workload, meet deadlines and complete activities (including ability to work within scope of practice and seek assistance when required) as delegated by supervising Allied Health Professional.
- Demonstrated ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team, and independently
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Demonstrated computer literacy and willingness to utilise required software

Desirable qualifications, competencies and experiences:

- Knowledge of wellness, re-ablement approaches and restorative approaches in a community setting
- Knowledge of the objectives of the Commonwealth Funded Aged Care programs including the Commonwealth Home Support Program and the Home Care Package program

- Current unrestricted drivers licence
