Red Cross is looking for Volunteer Community Speakers to share their stories of seeking asylum in Australia as part of an educational program talking to primary school students. If you have an interest in sharing your story of seeking asylum in Australia and;

- Currently hold a Permanent Protection Visa or Temporary Protection Visa (TPV)
- Feel comfortable speaking in public
- Available once a month for 3-5 hours during school hours (9am – 3pm)

Then, consider volunteering for Red Cross with the In Search of Safety program. Volunteer Community Speakers will have access to:

- Training opportunities
- Ongoing support while volunteering
- Reimbursement for travel expenses
- Interpreters if required

Training and ongoing support will be provided to Volunteer Community Speakers. Police Check and Working with Children Check are required. Occasional travel to regional areas may be required.
