Tax law and policy: Natural resources and energy justice

An opportunity exists for a PhD candidate with an interest in taxation law and policy reform in relation to natural resources, such as minerals and petroleum (oil and gas), and/or renewable energy. Appropriate areas of focus might be on tax incentives, resource rent tax, royalties or resource disputes, such as between Timor Leste and Australia.

A candidate with an interest in research within an 'energy justice' framework is also welcome. Energy justice is a decision-support tool for policy-makers to balance the energy 'trilemma' of competing aims: economics (finance), politics (energy security) and environment (climate change mitigation).
