- Assist with the preparation of meals, setting up venues, activities and equipment and ensure venues, vehicles and equipment are left in a good condition and equipment is safely stored.
- Attend any relevant briefing, de-briefing and training sessions relevant to the safe delivery of community activities and events
- Work in accordance with all Red Cross policies and procedures.

Knowledge, skills and experience

- Understanding of and respect for Aboriginal culture and the ability to work with Aboriginal people and their families in a culturally respectful way.
- Ability to engage and support Aboriginal people and encourage their participation in program activities.
- Ability to respond sensitively and appropriately to challenging situations.
- Ability to work as part of a team, follow policies and procedures and take direction from program managers.
