- Building the capacity of teachers in learning

- An understanding of contemporary learning theory and practices, and demonstrated record of success in leading contemporary learning
- Capacity to communicate effectively with leadership teams and teachers
- Demonstrated high level of pedagogical content knowledge in one or several Key Learning Areas e.g. Science, History, Literacy, Geography, Numeracy, ICT etc
- Capacity to implement pedagogical change
- Demonstrate effective application of digital technologies

- Capacity to mentor and coach school leaders of learning
- Proven capacity to manage work load and work management,
- Demonstrate initiative and a high degree of interpersonal skills
- Successful experience as a teacher
- Appropriate graduate qualifications and experience

- Actively promote the integration of Church values within Catholic education and the mission of Catholic schools
- Demonstrate an openness to professional learning and flexible ways of working
- Model teaching practices, co-teach, observing and providing support
