KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Specific duties required of a Level C practice academic may include:

- 1. innovation in a clinical or professional context (eg. development of clinical techniques, outstanding designs/patents or best practice approaches within a profession)
- 2. providing links between the academy and industry
- 3. supervision of students in advanced or speciality training programs
- 4. contributing to scholarly debate within the profession (eg. publishing in practice journals)
- 5. publishing state and national guidelines for clinical or professional practice
- 6. successful applications for competitive research funds
- 7. conference presentations in the area of speciality

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

Education/Qualifications

- 1. The appointee will have:
 - a doctoral qualification in the relevant discipline area and/or equivalent professional or clinical experience, or
 - a medical degree and registrable with the Malaysian Medical Council, and a specialist qualification or similar.

Knowledge and Skills

2. High level of interpersonal skills and proven ability to establish a good working relationship with colleagues and students, and to maintain strong professional links with relevant industry and the community

- 3. Demonstrated ability in undertaking clinical or industry-based research and leading a research team and project
- **4.** Demonstrated record of successfully mentoring and supervising course work and HDR students in clinical or industry-based settings
- **5.** Demonstrated record of clinical or industry-based teaching experience in a tertiary environment including course coordination and subject material development
- 6. Proven ability, commitment and passion for engaging in scholarly and research activities
