Position Purpose

This position will provide specific project management lifecycle advice and ensure compliance on contract construction projects to support contract delivery including the surveillance of the construction process in accordance with relevant legislation, standards and regulations.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

As a Project Engineer and member of the Project Management team you will:

- Provide support to the Project Manager to implement and maintain project controls to assist with the delivery of complex projects.
- Provide support through whole of project life including design, procurement and delivery whilst ensuring adherence to time cost quality and safety objectives.
- Prepare project reports including updates on project status and procurement recommendations.
- Review and audit engineering drawings and technical specifications for construction projects to ensure compliance with business and project requirements.
- Assist with co-ordination of construction issues as they arise and consult with the Project Manager regarding appropriate resolution of works under the contract.
- Provide construction surveillance and auditing of projects in accordance with relevant construction and workplace health and safety legislation, standards and other regulations that may impact on work carried out.
- Provide oversight to the team to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused team culture.
- Build strong relationships and work collaboratively with internal and external stakeholders to ensure project deliverables and outcomes are achieved.
