### Purpose

Under general direction, gather, prepare, write, edit, produce, and output, continuous news bulletins for the ABC News Channel. Responsibilities include suggestions to assist and develop story and guest ideas as well as contributing ideas about how the editorial agenda is evolved throughout the day.

### Key Accountabilities

- Assist with production of News Channel bulletins, programs and digital platforms by writing and video editing television news stories, RVOs, overlays etc.
- Undertake a range of production tasks as directed by supervising producers across a 24 hour - 7 day roster.
- Under direction, build and output news bulletins to ensure the highest editorial and journalistic standards, and audience engagement.
- Maintain an understanding of all breaking and major developing stories, monitoring a wide range of media outlets/sources; develop and foster a wide network of contacts and sources.
- Check stories and content for factual and style errors/inconsistencies and ensure content is accurate, timely and innovative.
- Proactively suggest and develop story and guest ideas to improve the quality, variety and diversity of News Channel content.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
- Cooperate with any reasonable instruction, procedure or policy relating to safety and take reasonable care for your own safety and that of other people who may be affected by your conduct while at work. Additional WHS responsibilities apply to Managers and Supervisors, Team Directors, and other Officers.

1. Proficient Editorial Experience and judgement in a broadcast and digital platform.
2. Willing to work rotating shifts across a seven day roster.
3. Sound writing and desktop editing skills.

5. High level organisational and communication skills, as well as advanced problem solving and troubleshooting skills.
6. The capacity to identify opportunities to improve and develop content, as well as generating new content.
