Role purpose

The purpose of the role is to support the facilitation of the Women Together Program – a program that supports women from diverse cultural backgrounds to come together once a week for friendship and the sharing of knowledge and skills

Role responsibilities

- Support the program coordinator to facilitate a gathering of women once a week
- Transport of women in Red Cross vehicles to and from their homes to designated venues
- Complete relevant administrative processes as required
- Assist with activities for the women together program

Knowledge, skills and experience

- For this role you are required to have a current NT driver's licence and an ochre card
- Experience in working with women from diverse backgrounds

Check requirements

- A National Criminal History Check prior to commencement and renewed every three years (Australian Red Cross will arrange this)
- NT Working with Children Clearance
- Current NT Driver's Licence

Learning and development

- Complete Australian Red Cross online learning modules as required
- Attend Australian Red Cross Volunteer Induction, Program Training and ongoing training as required
- · Attend scheduled volunteer meetings, a minimum of two per year

General conditions
