

## ED Resident commencing January 2022

The Royal Hobart Hospital is the tertiary referral centre for the state of Tasmania. The hospital provides all general and specialty medical and surgical services as well as paediatrics, obstetrics and psychiatry and is the state's tertiary trauma centre. Our busy, Emergency Department provides care for 65 000 patients annually with an admission rate of more than 35% and a paediatric case load of 25%. We also run a 10 bed short stay Emergency Medical Unit.

Consultants provide direct clinical supervision of the department from 8:00 am until 11:00 pm, seven days a week. Senior Registrars provide supervision overnight.

A non-rotational Emergency Department RMO year is a valuable opportunity to be exposed to a large variety of both high acuity and low acuity patients and allows development of a range of clinical and procedural skills. The broad experience attained can be used as a stepping-stone to any career in medicine, in particular the critical care specialties and General Practice. For those wishing to continue with a career in Emergency Medicine it will fulfil the ED time required to apply for ACEM training and many of our previous Residents have ultimately transitioned into ED Registrar positions.

A year in our ED could also be used to gain additional qualifications in Emergency Medicine. Our department is an approved training site with accredited supervisors for the Emergency Medicine Certificate and Emergency Medicine Diploma.

For international medical graduates, there is a comprehensive approach to Workplace Based Assessments in which you are provided support to meet the requirements to obtain General Registration with AHPRA.

There is 1.5 hours of protected teaching each week with a curriculum focussed on critical care. There are also plenty of on the job teaching opportunities.

Hobart is a compact but vibrant city offering access to fine dining, impressive arts and a wide choice of accommodation within a very short commute. Hobart also provides a great starting point to explore Tasmania's pristine wilderness and enjoy the challenges of varied outdoor activities.
