Organisational Environment

Airservices is a government owned organisation providing safe, secure, efficient, and environmentally responsible services to the aviation industry. Each year we manage over four million aircraft movements carrying more than 140 million passengers and provide air navigation services across 11 per cent of the world's airspace.

Airservices has two major operating centres in Melbourne and Brisbane and a corporate office in Canberra. We operate 29 air traffic control towers at international and regional airports and provide aviation rescue firefighting services at 26 Australian airports.

As an Asset Lifecycle Investment Planning Specialist, you will maintain asset lifecycle cost model and facilitate portfolio definition process for the Asset & Capability Lifecycle Management unit to inform Portfolio Investment and Delivery Plans.
