Specific Duties/Responsibilities:	 Care of infants and families utilising a Family Integrated Care approach
	 Ability to provide feeding including breast feeding/parent crafting education
	 Ability to Care for infants requiring basic respiratory support systems -> High flow 0₂ and CPAP therapy
	Mechanical ventilation (if qualified)
	PICC/Central line knowledge and skill
	 Knowledge of medication management for infants and children

- Ability to apply basic neonatal/paediatric resuscitation skills
- Ability to adapt and care for a wide variety of patients and families
- Excellent understanding of infection control procedures
