Ensure a high standard of communication and collaboration between News Digital and Social teams and the Network and Regional & Local teams. Provide advice on rostering requirements for digital and social.
- Foster a positive collaborative working environment with teams in WA newsroom, Regional & Local in WA and across the ABC.
- Coordinate the implementation of new digital technology and support change management initiatives, as required.
- Respond to editorial, technical and production issues to ensure fast, efficient and reliable delivery of news services for local audiences and WA stories that are of national interest.
