Barossa Hills Fleurieu Local Health Network (BHFLHN) encompasses 40% of the population of country South Australia, including the Barossa, Gawler district, Adelaide Hills, Southern Fleurieu and Kangaroo Island. Our network consists of 11 public hospitals, one private hospital (co-located with Southern Fleurieu Health Service), a community health service providing services across the region, and six residential aged care facilities.
