ORGANISATIONAL CONTEXT

POSITION PURPOSE

A Level C academic is expected to make contributions to the teaching effort of the University and to carry out activities to maintain and develop their scholarly, research and/or professional activities relevant to the profession or discipline.

The academic will develop, teach and administer undergraduate, postgraduate and executive education programs in the area of Business Analytics within the School. The academic will also be responsible for undertaking activities that maintain and develop scholarly research and the professional activities that are related to the discipline.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Specific duties required of a Level C academic may include:

- 1. The conduct of tutorials, practical classes, demonstrations, workshops, student field excursions, clinical sessions and/or studio sessions
- 2. Initiation and development of subject material
- 3. Course coordination
- 4. The preparation and delivery of lectures and seminars
- 5. Supervision of major honours or postgraduate research projects
- **6.** Supervision of the program of study of honours students and of postgraduate students engaged in course work
- 7. The conduct of research
- 8. Significant role in research projects including, where appropriate, leadership of a research team
- 9. Involvement in professional activity
- 10. Consultation with students
- 11. Broad administrative functions
- 12. Marking and assessment
- **13.** Attendance at departmental, school and/or faculty meetings and a major role in planning or committee work

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

Education/Qualifications

- 1. The appointee will have:
 - A doctoral qualification in the relevant discipline area or equivalent accreditation and standing and/or recognised significant experience in the relevant discipline area

In determining experience relative to qualifications, regard shall be had to teaching experience, experience in research, experience outside tertiary education, creative achievement, professional contributions and/or contributions to technical achievement. In addition, a position at this level will normally require a record of demonstrable scholarly and professional achievement in the relevant discipline area.

Knowledge and Skills

- 2. Ability to teach basic to advanced levels of business analytics topics such as data visualisation, data mining and statistical learning among others, with expertise in software's such as R and Python
- **3.** Has background in machine learning, statistics, econometrics, operations research, or any other similar discipline involving the analysis of big data
- **4.** Possess experience with data analysis problems arising in business (e.g. having worked full-time as a data analyst/scientist, statistical consultant, or having a high ranking as a Kaggle competitor)
- **5.** Possess a high level of interpersonal skills and demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a team across both the education and service sectors
- **6.** Demonstrated publication record in high-quality refereed journals, conferences equivalent textbooks or teaching resources
- 7. Demonstrated ability in undertaking outstanding research and leading a research team and project
- 8. Proven record of obtaining external grants for research
- 9. Demonstrated record of successfully supervising postgraduate research students
- **10.** Ability to work positively and cooperatively with students, internal and external teams and external organisations
- 11. Demonstrated strong record of teaching experience in a tertiary environment including course coordination
- 12. Proven ability, commitment and passion for engaging in scholarly and research activities
- 13. A demonstrated capacity to work in a collegiate manner with other staff in the workplace
