## Purpose

  - o Participate on 24x7 on call support periodically.
- Provide technical leadership in the storage space to the team, explore new technologies (including Cloud), and proactively identify and implement improvements to modernise Storage capabilities.
- Manage assigned projects within agreed timeframes and to the required standards to ensure achievement of team's objectives. Provide progress reports including management reports as required.
- Maintain detailed technical knowledge of ABC's Storage infrastructure; and create and maintain technical standards and support documentation.

- Provide specialist advice and consultation to internal clients and Technology Management on very complex technology issues involved in the planning, implementation and management of storage and backup systems.
- Support the Storage Team Leader in leadership by providing development, guidance, support and supervision to team members to build and maintain a collaborative and high-performance culture.
