Contribute to patient screening, oral diagnosis and emergency dental care

Interact with dental specialists within OHCWA to facilitate patient care

Collaborate with School and OHCWA management to further continuing professional education opportunities, leadership, scholarly activity and advanced skills acquisition as required

Provide advice on the development of dental care programs in OHCWA to the Clinical Operations Manager and develop plans for their implementation as required

Provide support in the development of continuing education programs for clinical and auxiliary staff and implement appropriate in-house training as required

Apply and assist in the development of clinical policies and procedures, including those relating to radiation and infection control as required

Substantial experience in a clinical setting

Dental qualification registrable with the Dental Board of Australia

High level clinical skills across the range of dental disciplines
