Position Purpose

This position will provide specialist technical engineering advice and undertake investigations for a range of coastal infrastructure and coastal management matters to meet the needs of the community within the Moreton Bay Regional Council area.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As a Senior Coastal Engineer within the Drainage, Waterways and Coastal Planning team you will:

- Provide specialist technical engineering advice to key stakeholders in the planning and design of coastal infrastructure and coastal management activities to drive integrated and sustainable outcomes.
- Investigate coastal management problems and prepare and present technical reports and recommendations to ensure project outcomes are met.
- Undertake design studies to support infrastructure projects and long-term strategic planning and growth (including management of specialist consultants).
- Support the planning and delivery of coastal infrastructure and coastal management projects, including completing concept designs, preparation of cost estimates, and the acquisition of necessary approvals to ensure project outcomes are achieved.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of asset management plans relating to Coastal Protection and Coastal Facilities asset classes, including the ongoing monitoring & condition assessment of coastal assets, and development of long-term maintenance and renewal programs.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Engage with internal and external stakeholders to ensure coastal infrastructure and service delivery outcomes are achieved.
